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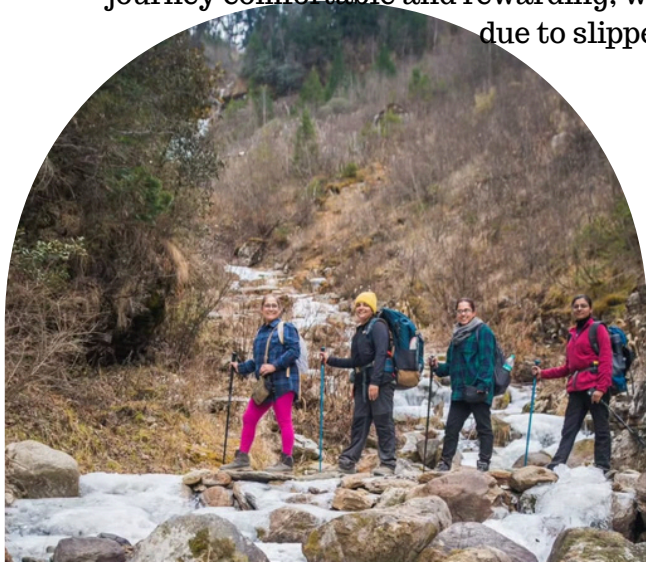


GULABI KANTHA

Gulabi Kantha Trek is a beautiful offbeat trek in Uttarakhand, perfect for trekkers looking for solitude and raw Himalayan charm. Nestled at an altitude of around 12,500 ft, Gulabi Kantha is known for its wide alpine meadows that turn lush green in summer and blush pink during the flowering season, giving the trek its name. The trail passes through dense oak and rhododendron forests, remote villages, and peaceful campsites, offering uninterrupted views of prominent Himalayan peaks like Bandarpunch, Swargarohini, and Kala Nag.

The highlight of the trek is the Gulabi Kantha summit, which rewards trekkers with a stunning 360-degree panoramic view of the Garhwal Himalayas. Compared to popular treks like Kuari Pass, Gulabi Kantha remains relatively unexplored, making it ideal for nature lovers and photographers. Suitable for beginners with decent fitness, this trek is best done between April to June and September to November, when the weather is clear and the landscapes are at their best.

The best time to visit Gulabi Kantha Trek is from April to June and September to November, when the weather remains pleasant and the trail is at its most scenic. During summer, the meadows bloom with colorful wildflowers and offer clear views of snow-capped Himalayan peaks, while post-monsoon months bring crisp air, golden landscapes, and excellent visibility. These seasons provide stable trekking conditions, making the journey comfortable and rewarding, whereas the monsoon months are generally avoided due to slippery trails and landslides.

Day 1

Dehradun → Hanuman Chatti / Nishni

Day 1: Dehradun → Hanuman Chatti / Nishni begins with an early morning drive through the scenic hills of Uttarakhand, following the Yamuna River as you leave the city behind. The route passes through Mussoorie, Nainbagh, and Purola, offering beautiful views of terraced fields, pine forests, and small mountain towns. As the road climbs deeper into the Garhwal region, the air turns cooler and the landscapes more dramatic, before reaching Hanuman Chatti or Nishni, the base point for the Gulabi Kantha trek, where you can relax, acclimatize, and prepare for the trekking days ahead.



Day 2

Hanuman Chatti → Kandola Chhani → Seema Thatch

Day 2: Hanuman Chatti → Kandola Chhani → Seema Thatch marks the beginning of the trek as you walk through dense oak and rhododendron forests, gradually gaining altitude along well-defined mountain trails. The route passes through Kandola Chhani, a scenic shepherd settlement, before opening up into wide alpine clearings. As you reach Seema Thatch, you're welcomed by expansive meadows, fresh mountain air, and peaceful surroundings, making it a perfect campsite to enjoy sunset views and experience the raw beauty of the Garhwal Himalayas.



Day 3

Seema Thatch → Gulabi Kantha Summit
Return to Camp

Day 3: Seema Thatch → Gulabi Kantha Summit → Return to Camp is the most rewarding day of the trek, starting early as you ascend through rolling alpine meadows toward the summit. The climb becomes steeper near the top, but the effort is well worth it as the Gulabi Kantha Summit offers breathtaking 360-degree views of towering peaks like Bandarpunch, Swargarohini, and Kala Nag. After spending time soaking in the panoramic scenery and capturing photographs, you descend carefully back to Seema Thatch, enjoying the changing colors of the meadows and a peaceful evening at camp.



Day 4

Seema Thatch → Hanuman Chatti

Day 4: Seema Thatch → Hanuman Chatti begins with a relaxed descent as you retrace your steps through vast meadows and dense oak-rhododendron forests. Walking downhill makes the trek easier, allowing you to enjoy the serene surroundings, birdsong, and mountain views at a slower pace. By afternoon, you reach Hanuman Chatti, where the trek concludes, giving you time to unwind, reflect on the journey, and prepare for the return drive with unforgettable memories of Gulabi Kantha.



Day 5

Hanuman Chatti → Dehradun

Day 5: Hanuman Chatti → Dehradun marks the end of the Gulabi Kantha adventure as you begin an early morning drive back to the city. The journey retraces the scenic mountain roads through Purola, Nainbagh, and Mussoorie, offering final glimpses of river valleys, forests, and hillside villages. By evening, you arrive in Dehradun with beautiful memories of alpine meadows, Himalayan views, and a peaceful trekking experience in the Garhwal region.

PAYMENT POLICY

To confirm your booking with Walking The Himalayas / Berg Adventures Pvt. Ltd., the following payment terms apply:

Advance Payment

- A minimum advance payment is required at the time of booking:
 - ₹5,000 per person for Trek Packages
 - ₹10,000 per person for Road Trips / Travel Trips
- The remaining balance must be paid in full before the start of the trip.

Modes of Payment

Bookings can be made through the following payment methods:

- NEFT / UPI / SWIFT
- Bank Transfer
- Cash (as per government guidelines)
- GST: 5% GST is applicable on all bookings and will be added to the total package cost.



Booking Closure

The last date for booking is 4 days before the trip departure date.

Guests are strongly advised to go ahead and confirm seat availability and departure dates with our team via call or email before making any online booking or payment.

TCS on Cash Payments

- If the total invoice amount exceeds ₹2,00,000 and the payment (full or partial) is made in cash (either at the counter or deposited into the bank), then:
 - 1% TCS (Tax Collected at Source) will be charged as per government rules.
 - The applicable TCS amount must be paid extra over and above the invoice value.
 - A copy of the PAN card is mandatory in such cases.

Flight Booking Policy

- For all flight ticket bookings, full payment is mandatory at the time of booking, as per the prevailing airfare.

CANCELLATION POLICY

The applicable refund amount will be processed within 10 business days. All applicable refunds will be done in the traveler's Walking The Himalayas wallet as WTH cash.

In the event of cancellation of any trip/adventure activity services due to any avoidable/unavoidable reasons, we must be notified the same via mail at help@walkingthehimalayas.com

No cancellations will be taken over the call or WhatsApp message. Please reply to the email of the payment receipt that you have received at the time of booking regarding the cancellation.

- Before 30 days: 90% of the total Land Package Cost is refundable
- Between 21-30 days: 75% of the total Land Package Cost is refundable
- Between 11-20 days: 50% of the total Land Package Cost is refundable
- Less than 10 days: No refund

Refund will be processed within 10 working days after the cancellation date.

Cancellation charges will be calculated on your booking and the cancellation charges shall depend on the date of departure and date of cancellation.
