How to reach

By Air: Patanagar airport is the nearest domestic airport, approximately 50 km away from the town. From here, you can hire a taxi to reach your resort in Corbett. Apart from that, the IGI airport in New Delhi is the nearest International airport (approximately 235 km), which is well-connected with different cities across the globe (Though this is not a preferred option).

By Rail: The nearest railhead from Jim Corbett is Ramnagar, connected to major destinations such as Delhi Haridwar, Lucknow, and Varanasi.

By Road: The route to drive down to Corbett from New Delhi is via Noida, Hapur, Muradabad, Kashipur, and on to Ramnagar. Corbett is well-connected via Ramnagar by bus. There are daily buses from Delhi, Haridwar, and Nainital to Ramnagar.

With its hills, grasslands and streams, it is ideal tiger territory. The place from where Project Tiger was launched in 1973, with its tiger population at 163, it boasts of a single largest tiger population in a tiger reserve and one of the highest tiger densities in the country. Home to a number of species, including 600 elephants and over 600 species of birds, the majestic forest is a big draw with tourists.



Corbett Itinerary

No of Days: 3D/2N (Ramnagar to Ramnagar)



Day 1: Arrival at Jim Corbett | Welcome to the oldest National Park of India

Upon your arrival at the resort in Corbett National Park, our representatives will help you settle in and complete all the check-in formalities.

The rest of the day is at your leisure.

You can choose to explore nearby places as the Dhangarhi museum or Corbett falls.

In the evening, you will return to the resort for dinner

Day 2: Jeep safari through Corbett National Park | Drive into the Land of Tigers

Wake up early in the morning and head out for an early morning visit to Garjia Dev Temple

In the evening you will board an open jeep and will be driven through the entire Corbett National Park accompanied by an expert from the resort to give you a guided explanation about the wild animals, and their habitats.

The Safari will take you into the areas where the chances of spotting the Royal Bengal tigers and other wildlife species is quite high.

Once the safari concludes, you will return to the resort.

You can enjoy recreational activities around the resort-like swimming and indoor games.

Day 3: Departure | Depart with memories from the Forest

After breakfast, pack your bags and check out from the resort. Head back to home loaded with wonderful photographs and happy memories.
